Nicki's breakout session covered recent changes to Chapter 35A of the North Carolina General Statutes which outlines adjudications of incompetence and guardianships. Some of these significant changes include a requirement to consider "less restrictive alternatives" before pursuing guardianship, a new Notice of Rights to be served on the Respondent, changes to guardianship accounting rules, and new tools for effective guardianship oversight and management.
